## TERMS & CONDITIONS

Your prices/rates must been FOB basis up to international Airport including inland 1. freight/cartage/forwarding/documents & boarding charges etc. 2.

Freight and insurance will be arranged by NPL. The mode of dispatch to be followed by you must be

All bank charges in the exporting country will be on the exporters account. 3.

The blue/catalogue/pamphlets/literature and Instruction Manual must be attached along with your 4. quotation/performs invoice. 5.

The shipment through courier services will not be accepted unless beneficiary takes the responsibility of delivery of goods at NPL. But in that case payment shall be made after receipt of goods at NPL. 6.

The shipment must be affected through our consolidation agent. The details of our consolidation agent 7.

Payment will be made against L/C/ sight Draft at our sight. We always prefer payment against sight Draft/TT at our sight to avoid L/C opening bank charges in India as well as in Exporting Country.

INSTALLATION: The equipment should be installed/commissioned and demonstrated by the 8. supplier/Indian agent at our site immediately but in any case within two months after receipt of the item in the lab and the same will be put under operation to the satisfaction of our technical expert/Scientist who will test the performance of the equipment. No separate charges for installation etc. will be paid to the party 9.

The goods must be guaranteed for a period of 12 months from the date of its satisfactory installation at NPL If the whole material/equipment is found defective during the guarantee period the same will have to be replaced/repaired at NPL free of charge on CIF basis. 10.

NO ADVANCE PAYMENT WILL BE MADE IN ANY CONDITION.

COMMENCEMENT OF WARRANTY PERIOD: The warranty period of an item shall commence 11. from the date of receipt of the item in good working condition. 12.

PENALTY CLAUSE: In case of delay in supply and installation on part of the supplier, a penalty @ 0.5% per week subject to maximum 10% of Order/FOB value will be charged for delayed period. 13.

DISPUTE SETTLEMENT: The Purchaser and the Supplier shall make every effort to resolve amicably by direct informal negotiation any disagreement or dispute arising between them under or in connection with

If, after twenty-one (21) days, the parties have failed to resolve their dispute or difference by such mutual consultation, then either the Purchaser or the Supplier may give notice to the other party of its intention to commence arbitration, as hereinafter provided, as to the matter in dispute, and no arbitration in respect of this matter may be commenced unless such notice is given. Any dispute or difference in respect of which a notice of intention to commence arbitration has been given in accordance with this Clause shall be finally settled by arbitration. Arbitration may be commenced prior to or after delivery of the Goods

The dispute settlement mechanism/arbitration proceedings shall be concluded as under:

- (a) In case of Dispute or difference arising between the Purchaser and a domestic supplier relating to any matter arising out of or connected with this agreement, such disputes or difference shall be settled in accordance with the Indian Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996, the rules there under and any statutory modifications or re-enactments thereof shall apply to the arbitration proceedings. The dispute shall be referred to the Director General, Council of Scientific & Industrial Research and if he is unable to unwilling to act, to the sole arbitration of some other person appointed by his willing to act as such Arbitrator. The award of the arbitrator so appointed shall be final, conclusive and binding on all parties
- (b) In the case of a dispute between the Purchase and a Foreign suppler, the dispute shall be settled by arbitration in accordance with provision of sub-clause (a) above. But if this is not acceptable to the supplier then the dispute shall be settled in accordance with provisions of UNCITRAL (United Nations Commission on International Trade Law) Arbitration Rules.

The venue of the arbitration shall be the place from where the purchase order or contract is issued.

Notwithstanding any reference to arbitration herein,

- (a) The parties shall continue to perform their respective obligations under the contract unless they
- (b) The purchase shall pay the Supplier any monies due the Supplier.

## DETAILED SPECIFICATION FOR NOISE MONITORING SYSTEM

- Measurement Mode: 24 hours continuous monitoring, Class 1 Precision integrating sound level analyzer and weather proof ½ inch low self noise outdoor microphone fulfilling IEC 61672 Class 1.
- Measurement Parameters:
   Leq in A, C and Z weightings, Statistical noise parameters L<sub>10</sub>, L<sub>90</sub>, L<sub>50</sub>, L<sub>n</sub> etc.
- Functionality and Calibration:
   System should operate as a self contained unit enclosed in a portable weather proof case. The sound level analyzer should be spot calibrated using an ½ inch Acoustical Calibrator.
- Memory: System should have sufficient memory to record atleast 48 hours noise measurement
- Power back up: Charger and battery back up built in should support the continuous running of system for at least 24 hours.
- Software: Software for data processing & reporting the time domain and frequency domain (1/1 octave and 1/3<sup>rd</sup> octave spectrum) measurements both hourly and for the whole day.
- Accessories:
   System should additionally log the weather data (temperature, pressure, humidity & wind speed)
- Serial printer: Portable compatible printer for printing the in-situ noise measurements
- Optional Accessories: ½ inch precision condenser microphone and compatible ½ inch microphone preamplifier
- Environmental Conditions: System should be capable of working in temperature upto 45 °C without any change in the above specifications.
