CSIR-NPL is accepting students desirous of full-time, continuous, on-site training who are studying:

- ME/ MTech/ MSc/ MS/ BE/ BTech Final Year, 6 months to 1 year training duration
- ME/MTech/MSc/ BE/BTech 2nd/ 3rd Year, Short-Term Training, 6 to 8 weeks training duration

Conditions of Training:

- The training must be completed in one stretch and is full-time and on-site. CSIR-NPL has a five-day week, and lab timings are from 9 am to 5.30 pm.
- Students are expected to report on time and may not leave the lab before closing time.
- No extension in the training period will be entertained.

Selection procedure:

- CSIR-NPL has a flexible selection procedure for each session, based primarily on the requirement of our scientists and the applicants
- Preference will be given to students from Institutes of National Importance and Centrally Funded Technical Institutions.
- Students should apply at least two months prior to the starting of their training calendars, ie, if a student wants to start his/her training from August 2022, s/he should apply before 30th of May, 2022.

Cost:

- A one-time nominal amount of Rs. 7,000/-+ GST will be charged by NPL as 'Token Money' from Student Trainees (0-6 months duration).
- A student can also undergo training without any fees. In that case, no IP right can be claimed by the student or his/her college guide and an undertaking has to be given by the student on this. The certificate will be provided in NPL format only

Hostel Accommodation:

• No hostel accommodation is available for students.

Requirements:

- Students wishing to train with NPL will need to bring a signed permission letter from his/her institute.
- Students are advised to go through the student requirement link of scientists and contact the suitable scientist for the discussion on research areas. If the research areas match, then s/he should contact HRD for further procedure. <u>CLICK HERE</u> to view the research areas of scientists along with their requirements.
- Original and photocopy of both sides of college ID Card.
- Original and photocopy of only ONE mark sheet, the last available semester's marksheet. For example, a student wishing to intern in the seventh semester must bring the sixth-semester mark sheet. In case only a printout from the University website is possible, the printout must be signed and stamped by the college authorities.
